Response to Resistance Incidents (RTR)

Force was used in 0.07% of Police/Citizen Interactions and in 2.10% of all Arrests made. (1 in 1,791 per capita)



Officer Involved Shootings of Suspects (OIS)

0.002% of all Police/Citizen Interactions involved OIS incidents. 0.06% of all Arrests made included OIS incidents. 3.0% of all RTR Incidents involved OIS incidents. (1 in 59,663 per capita)

Response to Resistance Incident (RTR): The incident which involves an application of force. Use of Force: The actual application of force whereby an officer utilizes a within-policy maneuver and/or technique to establish control of the subject(s).

Methods of Use of Force include: Taser / Physical / Chemical / Intermediate Weapon / Firearm
