Arrests were made in 3.55% of all Police Calls for Service completed.

Force was used in 0.07% of the Police Calls for Service and in 1.99% of all arrests made.

*In 2020, there were 533 RTR incidents.




0.001% of all Police Calls for Service involved OIS incidents.
