

#### **ARRESTS**

Arrests were made in 3.80% of all Police Calls for Service completed.

\*In 2021, there were 26,447 arrests made.



#### RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE INCIDENTS

Response to resistance occurred in 0.09% of the Police Calls for Service and in 2.51% of all arrests made.

\*In 2021, there were 526 RTR incidents.

#### OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTINGS

1.97% of all RTR Incidents involved OIS Incidents.

.05% of all arrests made included OIS incidents.

**Response to Resistance (RTR) Incident:** An incident that involves an application of force.

**Use of Force:** The actual application of force whereby an officer uses a within-policy maneuver and/or technique to respond to the resistance of a subject(s). **Methods of Use of Force include:** Chemical / Conducted Energy Weapons (TASER®) / Firearm / Intermediate Weapon / Physical
