

Arrests were made in 3.53% of all Police Calls for Service completed.

\*In 2022, there were 28,279 arrests made.

Response to resistance occurred in 0.09% of the Police Calls for Service and in 2.74% of all arrests made.

\*In 2022, there were 710 RTR incidents.



.0017% of all Police Calls for Service involved OIS incidents.

1.76% of all RTR Incidents involved OIS Incidents.

.047% of all arrests made included OIS incidents.

One OIS did not result in an arrest.

\*In 2022, there were 14 OIS cases.

**Response to Resistance (RTR) Incident:** An incident that involves an application of force.

**Use of Force:** The actual application of force whereby an officer uses a within-policy maneuver and/or technique to respond to the resistance of a subject(s). **Methods of Use of Force include:** Chemical / Conducted Energy Weapons (TASER®) / Firearm / Intermediate Weapon / Physical
